**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS,** Michigan Pet Fund Alliance (MPFA) is committed to increasing the number of trap-neuter-return programs to control cat populations; and

**WHEREAS,** MPFA is offering a grant of \$5,000 to launch such a program; and

**WHEREAS,** the Berrien County Animal Control seeks to apply for the grant and if awarded, will follow grant requirements to include but not limited to completing the trap-neuter-return of a minimum of 20 cats before November 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS,** the grant requires no match; and


**WHEREAS,** the deadline for applying is February 14, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorizes the Animal Control Department to submit the grant application for the MPFA grant in the amount of \$5,000 to be used exclusively for a trap-neuter-return program to reduce the number of stray cats in Berrien County.




