

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN:
Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorized a contract with the Michigan Department of Corrections as a grant recipient for multiple Community Corrections programs (Resolution #A1809318); and

WHEREAS, at the recommendation of the Community Corrections Advisory Board, the Berrien County Trial Court wishes to contract with Kalamazoo Probation Enhancement Program (KPEP) for the purposes of providing services for the Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT) and the Felony Probation Work Program, two of the programs referenced above; and

WHEREAS, Berrien County received a grant for the MRT program in the amount of \$14,250 and for the Felony Probation Work Program in the amount of \$41,800; and


WHEREAS, KPEP will provide MRT program services for an amount not to exceed \$14,250; and

WHEREAS, KPEP will provide the Felony Probation Work Program services for an amount not to exceed \$41,800; and


WHEREAS, the contract with KPEP has been reviewed and approved by Corporate Counsel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners to sign the contract with Kalamazoo Probation Enhancement Program for providing the MRT and Felony Probation Work Programs for the grant period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.


