

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN:
Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Road Department Engineering Supervisor reported construction has started on the Buckhorn Creek culvert replacement project on M-139; and

WHEREAS, a traffic engineering study has been conducted by the Berrien County Road Department on Linco Road, Hollywood Road, Scottdale Road, and John Beers Road in Royalton Township on the MDOT signed detour route during this construction project; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the traffic engineering study, the Engineering Supervisor recommends a temporary speed limit, as authorized under Section 257.628 of the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code, of 45 M.P.H. on county roads being used as a detour route during construction – the portions of Linco Road, Hollywood Road, Scottdale Road, and John Beers Road that are being used.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners, in accordance with Section 257.628 of the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code by its authority, set the temporary speed limit of forty five miles per hour (45 M.P.H.) on those portions of Linco Road, Hollywood Road, Scottdale Road, and John Beers Road being used as a detour route in Royalton Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the temporary speed limit is to be in effect during construction of the Buckhorn Creek culvert replacement project on M-139 or until the Berrien County Road Department determines otherwise, and directs the Road Department to erect signage indicating the established speed limit, that shall be maintained in conformity with the “Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices”.
