

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN:
Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation has begun a construction project on M-139 to replace the Buckhorn Creek culvert; and

WHEREAS, a detour route was established taking traffic down Linco Road, Hollywood Road, and John Beers Road in Royalton Township during this construction project; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the authority vested in the Michigan Transportation Commission, PA328 of 1931, MCLA 750.497, Section 497 of the Michigan Penal Code, and Act 300 of 1949, the maximum speed limits on the following are hereby ordered:

- Forty-five (45) miles per hour along John Beers Road from M-139 to Hollywood;
- Forty-five (45) miles per hour along Hollywood Road from John Beers Road to Linco Road; and
- Forty-five (45) miles per hour along Linco Road from Hollywood Road to M-139.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners confirms this temporary traffic control order (SP-T 11-015-21) retroactive to July 8, 2021 through October 4, 2021 to complement their resolution #A2107275 stating same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the temporary speed limit is to be in effect during construction of the Buckhorn Creek culvert replacement project on M-139 and the Road Department is directed to erect signage indicating the established speed limit, that shall be maintained in conformity with the "Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all police agencies having jurisdiction therein shall enforce said regulation.
