TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a valid petition and certification has been received seeking the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of the following sections of road located in the Village of Bertrand, sub-division:

- Monroe Street, from Berris to Bertrand, 1140' X 80'
- Jackson Street, from Berris to Bertrand, 1140' X 80'
- Silspee Street from Madison to Monroe, 325' X 80' and from Monroe to Jackson, 325' X 80'
- Garnsey Street from Jackson to 3rd Street, 325' X 80' and from Monroe west 278' X 52'

WHEREAS, these sections of road are county road right-of-ways that has not been improved upon and is listed as a public road not open; and

WHEREAS, Mr. & Mrs. Michael Sriver are the owners of lots #35 and #36 in the Village of Bertrand, sub-division; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Douglas Sriver is the owner of lot #25 and #26 in the Village of Bertrand, sub-division; and

WHEREAS, Niles Charter Township officials have offered their support of the listed abandonment and discontinuance of the described unimproved, public road right-of-way; and


WHEREAS, all adjoining property owners have signed the petition for the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of the above named section of right-of-way and no formal objections have been provided from the parties that may be effected; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners approves the abandonment and discontinuance of the following right-of-ways in Niles Charter Township, Berrien County, Michigan:


- Monroe Street, from Berris to Bertrand, 1140' X 80'
- Jackson Street, from Berris to Bertrand, 1140' X 80'
- Silspee Street from Madison to Monroe, 325' X 80'
- Silspee Street from Monroe to Jackson, 325' X 80'
- Garnsey Street from Jackson to 3rd Street, 325' X 80'
- Garnsey Street from Monroe west 278' X 52'


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that easements are reserved for any existing public utilities and for drainage.
