

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Michigan State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) has distributed to all state courts access to the 2022 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) grant; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant program is to provide emergency supplemental funding to Michigan circuit, district, and probate courts to respond to the coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Trial Court is eligible to receive up to \$150,000 in grant funding for items including technology for remote work, staff overtime related to illness or quarantine, technology for remote hearings, and office supplies and equipment related to COVID-19 functions; and

WHEREAS, all awarded funds must be spent by the grantee by December 31, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorize the Berrien County Trial Court to apply for the 2022 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding grant for an amount up to \$150,000.




