

**TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN:** Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Michigan State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) has closed the FY 2022 Michigan Mental Health Court Program application process; and


**WHEREAS**, Berrien County has received an award in the amount of \$149,622, with an in-kind matching cost of \$13,447.10 (staffing costs), to continue the work being done in Berrien County; and


**WHEREAS**, this grant application is a cooperative partnership with Riverwood; and

**WHEREAS**, the goals of this program include: Linking 80% of the participants to mental health services within 21 days of screening; 100% of the participants remain substance free for 60 days prior to graduation, while in the program; 80% of the participants will not be convicted of a new offense; 100% of participants will establish stable living arrangements for at least 90 days prior to graduation; and 80% of the participants will be compliant with mental health treatment services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners accepts the FY 2022 Mental Health Court grant and authorizes the Trial Court Administrator to execute the award agreement via DocuSign.


