TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Michigan State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) has closed the FY 2022 Michigan Swift and Sure Sanctions Probation Program application process; and

WHEREAS, the program is based on the "Swift and Certain" probation program implemented in 2001 in Hawaii; and


WHEREAS, Berrien County has received an award in the amount of \$182,000, with an in-kind matching cost of \$6,250.70 (staffing costs), to continue the work being done in Berrien County; and

WHEREAS, the program utilizes two Michigan Department of Corrections (MDOC) agents, one of which is paid via additional funding through this grant and the inter-agency agreement between the SCAO and MDOC (\$75,000); and

WHEREAS, program goals include reducing the number and frequency of missed appointments with felony probation officers, reducing the number and frequency of positive drug and alcohol tests, reducing recidivism, and reducing the number of felony probation revocations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners accepts the FY 2022 Swift and Sure Sanctions Program grant and authorizes the Trial Court Administrator to execute the award agreement via DocuSign.


