With its forests, dunes and Lake Michigan shoreline, Berrien County has long been one of Michigan's most popular bird watching locations. With this in mind and to promote recreational birding and bird conservation in Southwest Michigan, the **Berrien County Parks** sponsors the **Berrien Birding Club**.

It is a friendly, field trip oriented club that offers group birding outings on a regular basis and usually with refreshments! The club also sponsors a local birding e-mail list serve - the BBC List - and has sponsored several projects to improve birding access at popular local birding locations.

In addition, the club helps sponsor the annual Southwest Michigan Team Birdathon and two Christmas Bird Counts. The club also supports the efforts of other local groups that protect bird habitat or offer birding opportunities such as Fernwood, Love Creek and Sarett Nature Centers, the Southwest Michigan Land Conservancy and Chikaming Open Lands.
